Our reading, writing & maths EXPECTED combined score is statistically significantly above national averages and indicates that we are in the top 4% of schools nationally. Our reading, writing & maths HIGHER STANDARD combined score is statistically significantly above national averages and indicates that we are in the top 1% of schools nationally

Children obtain a 'scaled score' at the end of key stage 2. Children who score 100 have met the expected standard. To achieve a higher standard, children need to score 110+. In writing, children who exceed the standard significantly are deemed to be working at 'greater depth'.
